STAR NORTH asked a bit in the early going, moved out turn, four wide turning for home when beginning to rally, challenged past the furlong marker, powered clear. HESAPRIVATE in the second flight toward the inside, roused for the drive, could not match strides with the winner late, edged clear for the place. SUSPECTING FIRE broke on top, cleared soon after, set the pace, proved no match for the top two, just lasted for the show. RUDDYS BUDDY off slowly, one paced from the start, lacked winning kick, outfinished for the show. SO SHINY off slowly, raced well back, moved out in upper stretch, displayed a modest amount of late interest. ROYAL BIDDER four wide trip, failed to menace. KATE'S BLUFF off slowly, was never close. HOWDY DOODY TIME gave way after a half. DEELITEFUL MOON off slowly, fell further and further back, distanced after losing contact with the field.
