ABBY THE GREAT unhurried in the early going, saved ground far turn, moved out then back in for the drive, rail bid, best. SKINNY LEGS N ALL set the pace just off the inside, allowed the winner the rail late, grudgingly. WON PESO off the pace, ranged up closer four wide in the second turn, flattened out a bit in the drive, still up for the show. LET'SPLAYGORGEIOUS allowed to settle, improved position just off the inside in the second turn, closest a furlong out, caught for the show. HIMYNAMEISSARAH also off the early pace, moved closest to the leader through the second turn, weakened in the short stretch run. MILLION BELLS off a bit awkward, steadied into the first turn, turned in an even effort. DISCRIMINATING four wide into the far turn when well off the pace, lacked a rally in the drive. MISSY MINER forwardly placed for three quarters off the inside, faltered. UNO RED BIRD was not a factor. CALLER A CLASSIC four wide when with the first flight in the first turn, gave way. LITTLE MISS A pressed, stopped.
