WAIMEA CANYON prompted the pace three wide, bid, long drive, gained the advantage, held late. HALF A WELL off the pace, advanced five wide late in the turn, came in, bumped foe midstretch, up late for the place. RUDDYS BUDDY broke out, raced forwardly and inside, moved out upper stretch, bumped, pushed in a bit, split foes, missed the place. LEXIS BRIEF FLAME broke sharp, set the pace for five furlongs, weakened final furlong toward the inside. DOIN BIG BIDNESS within striking distance, came up empty for the drive. RAN THE MAN settled off the pace, also failed to respond when asked through the stretch. KLUMSY veered in, bothered foe start, raced back, showed some mild belated interest. STATE LINE AVENUE cut off at the start, came six wide out of the turn, failed to threaten. IZZO broke out, in tight at the start, was finished early. UPTHERIVER tired in the drive. STAR NORTH bothered at the start, trailed throughout.
