### Footnotes

SIR MOTT settled off the pace while saving ground, shot through an opening midway on the final turn, quickly clear into the stretch, not threatened in the drive under steady handling. NINTH CLIENT four wide in the first turn, stalked while continuing outside, four wide again second turn, rallied for the place while no match for the winner. GENERAL PARTNER five wide in the first turn, raced off the inside, dropped inside, slipped through along the rail turning for home, closest to the winner a furlong out, caught for the place. PACAR void of early foot, continued back in the second turn, staged a belated rally while toward the inside. CLAYTON'S LUCK last away, trailed for six furlongs, came six wide into the lane, improved position while widest in the drive. BOBBY SANDS prompted the pace off the inside, weakened in the drive. MAGIC BULLET lacked speed, five wide out of the final turn, lacked a significant late response. MINER BIRD firmly rated, steadied in traffic three furlongs out, began to fade. YANKEE CONNECTION forward and off the inside, gave way in the drive. MINIMAST got clear early, set the pace, stopped when headed by the winner in the second turn.
