RED RIVER RISING rated off the pace and the inside, in some traffic into the far turn, advanced, outside bid, long drive, proved narrowly best in determined fashion. VIGORISH brushed at the start, took control before a quarter, set the pace, responded when challenged by the winner late in the final turn, long drive, missed in a game try. PENOBSCOT in tight at the start, raced well back, continued to trail far turn, dropped to the inside for the drive, managed a late run up the rail to be in time for the show. KEEN GIZMO within striking distance outside, four wide in the second turn, continued in even fashion through the lane to lose the show late. HARBOR BOUND back early, moved closer while five wide into the far turn, four path into the stretch, flattened out and was also going evenly at the end. COMMANDMENT off the pace while in hand, encountered traffic late backstretch, came up empty when clear for the drive. DENALI TIZ A PARK lacked speed, saved ground while continuing back, waited along the rail early in the far turn, worked way out to be five wide into the lane, improved position a bit after the issue had been decided. OPEN A TAP was never dangerous while racing in the three path. JOHNMAC DADDY four wide into the first turn when near the front, pressured the leader up the backstretch, weakened. SQUIDALEM remained always back. BROTHER STACHYS forwardly placed for a half, stopped.
