ANNIANO lacked early foot, rallied while off the inside exiting the turn, nice rally through traffic, kicked clear. WILD LIZ stalked the pace, took over from the outside entering the stretch, no match for the winner late. TRUE PLAY well back early, swung out five wide turning for home, staged a mild rally to finish best of the rest. MS. DOWDEN lacked a winning response. RISKY RUTH off a bit slow, well back early, found his best stride too late. MIGHTY PICTURE TOO sprinted clear soon after the start, gave way when displaced. ANNIE'S SISTER IDA settled early, advanced three wide through the turn, faltered in the drive. WHOSOEVERBELIEVETH tired from her early efforts. ARKIE'S NOZETTA lacked a response in the drive. ASHLEYS PAIGE in traffic early, faded. TALL IN SEATTLE steadily backed up. NOTATEAR steadied into the turn, fell back and was distanced through the stretch.
