Footnotes

NOBEL BIRD away in good order, allowed the pace to go while well off the inside, continued in the second flight into the turn, four wide when roused late in the turn, bid nearing the furlong marker, clear. SEA BUBBA broke in a bit, fell steadily back, far back late turn, angled out to be widest for the drive, closed with good late energy down the center of the strip to up for the place. NAUGHTY MOON bothered slightly at the start, raced back, two path turn, angled out to be four wide into the lane, rallied, not enough for the place. LATE ACT HERE in second group inside the winner, four wide into the lane, also did not have enough for the place spot late while between rivals late. SUSPECTING GOLD used a bit early to move up to vie, duelled turn off the inside, relinquished the lead to the winner with over a furlong to run, fell apart late. REINFORCE cut off at the start, raced back, five wide into the stretch, improved position, no real threat. PRINCE DUSTY was never dangerous while racing outside. MANE MISSION little left for the drive. INDY SKIES in mid pace, traffic stretch, came up empty. BO'S SHOES came in just after the start from outside pressure, straightened, set or forced pace for a half and gave way in the drive. KING PAI was never involved. STORMY ECHO gave way early, eased, walked off.
