**Footnotes**

ROYAL DEHERE broke alertly and inward, set the pace while in hand toward the inside, shook clear out of the turn, maintained a daylight advantage to the wire under steady handling. FAITHFUL SERVANT behind the pace, continued behind horses in some traffic late in the turn, steadied, eased out for room entering the stretch, could do little with the winner late, held the place. ENERGY'S PRIDE settled off the pace, raced in some traffic, traffic midway up the backstretch and into the turn, steered out, 5w, getting to the runner up. MAD ABOUT ALLI within striking distance, four wide while maintaining contact with the winner late turn, went evenly in the drive. FEATURE WINNER off the pace, three out to four wide in the turn, lacked a serious late kick. DUVALI pressured the issue from along the inside for a half and began to weaken. KING KID four wide trip throughout, tired. STREET BALLAD off slowly, trailed, showed little in a dull effort.
