INDEPENDENCE WAR allowed the pace to go early, made a strong move to reach contention on the outside turning for home, continued willingly to the finish to be well clear. MIDNIGHT ILLUSION forwardly placed, behind the first flight into the lane, split foes, proved game for the place while not a threat to the winner. EXPRESS RAIL off the pace, four wide into the lane, was along for the show. DIAMOND LAD vied up front along the inside, weakened in the drive. FIRE CHIEF vied up front while off the inside, weakened in the drive. WALL CLOUD lacked a late bid. MEGA WONDER was never seriously involved. SOMETINSPECTACULAR behind the pace toward the inside, waited briefly turn, failed to rally. NOAH'S TRAVELER forwardly placed for a half, stopped. BOONEVILLE WAS LEFT BEHIND THE GATE AT THE START, DECLARED A NON STARTER. ALL MONIES WAGERED ON BOONEVILLE WERE REFUNDED.
