Footnotes

CALDO CAT void of early foot, advanced through some traffic in the second turn to reach contention, four wide into lane, late bid, bothered, carried out late, finished with good determination to be up in time. WESTERN SUN in the second flight on the outside, took over in the second turn, well clear in upper stretch and past the furlong marker, drifted out late, weakened and was caught in the final strides by the winner while bothering that same foe. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE STRETCH RUN, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND. GOLD SILT allowed to settle inside the winner, moved closer to that foe after the latter had taken over, flattened out in the final furlong to finish best of the rest while also drifting out late. A. P. ELI settled in the middle of the pace, lacked a significant response. TEDDY'S DREAM last to leave, trailed for over a half, improved position while making little impact. DRASCO set or forced the pace for five furlongs and faltered. HUMOR FRED lacked a late bid. BOOMER SOOEY dueled up front off the inside, stopped. SIX FIRE was finished after a half.
