WAR AND THUNDER close from the start despite being bothered slightly, stalked into the turn three wide, challenged on the outside late in the bend, put a head in front when straightened for home, held sway while under steady handling. ANTHONY broke sharp, narrowly showed the way off the inside, vied between rivals past the furlong marker, proved stubborn to the end, just lasted for the place. CUP OF JOY lacked early foot, evenly paced into the lane, angled out, accelerated late and was going by far the best at the end to just miss the place. DENALI SILVER with the pace closest to the inside, two path into the lane, weakened the final furlong. ADMIRAL ROCKET fell back into the turn, moved outside for the roused, modest late interest. PARODY four wide most of the way, was never dangerous. POWERSCOUT broke out, trailed, passed tiring foes while never a threat. BONAROO lacked a rally. SPECIAL HEART within striking distance, backed up in the drive. SHIMMY TINJO steadily retreated.
