ZAP'EM took control soon after the start, set all the pace, remained well clear into the lane, held the runner up comfortably safe in the late going. THISTLEDEU forwardly placed, moved closest to the winner in the far turn while well off the inside, could do little with the winner the final furlong, held sway for the place. ABBIES MY DADDY evenly paced while racing off the inside, slowly getting to the runner up in the late going. WHY GO WEST void of early foot, improved inside of several rivals the middle half, angled out a bit for the drive, flattened out. FLATTER ME UP broke through the gate prior to the start then broke slowly, four wide into the first turn, continued outside, four wide through the second turn, went evenly in the drive. SANDWEE lacked speed, came four wide out of the final turn, also managed little in the way of a late bid. CHERRYFUL LADY forwardly placed for five furlongs, gave way. GINGER LEMON was never a threat. MADAME MISTLETOE broke through the gate prior to the start and ran off over a sixteenth, away in good order, chased, gave way far turn, eased.
