Footnotes

FRISBEE away in good order, set the pace two path, continued to show the way turn, shook well clear when straightened for home, held the runner up safe late despite her rider having lost his whip three sixteenths out. BELLE MUSE last away, trailed well back early, began to move late in the turn, split foes past the furlong marker, finished up willingly to be steadily getting to the winner. CRHOSSGO forwardly placed, pressured the winner three wide through the turn, had little for the top two in the drive, lasted for the show. GLOWING REPORT settled off the pace, came in slightly turning for home helping put THE GARDENER in tight turning for home, raced along the inside through the stretch, lacked a serious late kick. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF THE GARDENER AGAINST GLOWING REPORT FOR INTERFERENCE ENTERING THE STRETCH WAS NOT ALLOWED. T JAYS AFFAIR lacked speed, came four wide out of the turn, lacked a significant late punch. THE GARDENER within striking distance along the inside, lacked room entering the stretch, moved out, came up empty. MAZUCAMBERA moved up to press the winner early, vied between rivals through the turn, gave way in the drive. SUBJUGATE in the second flight outside, came five wide out of the turn, tired in the drive.
