**Footnotes**

TOUR'S ENERGY outrun early, ranged up four wide to challenge turning for home, quickly gained the advantage and cleared, held the runner up safe late. VERY VERY well back early, rallied six wide out of the turn, finished well to be getting to the winner. SYMBOL OF LOVE also void of early foot, traffic, split foes 3/16, willingly late. BIG CITY LOVER pressed early off rail, took over, could not last. TAHITI BLUES went evenly in lacking a late bid. HERR RUBY far back for a half, showed some belated interest. TARDY forwardly placed early, faded. D M SPECIAL also prompted the pace while outside, faltered. LADY'S PUNCH five wide turning for home, came up empty. SEEKING SNOWDROPS within striking distance off rail, was failing to respond when forced to steady upper stretch. GLENMARY set the early pace and began to fade before a half. AURORA G. was finished early, well back.
