COSMIC last away, devoid of any kind of early foot in trailing, began to advance five sixteenths out, got through along the rail turning for home, again nearing the furlong grounds while still inside, continued to exhibit a high turn of late speed to win going away. CHIEF OF AFFAIRS pressured the early leader outside that foe, took over, well clear a furlong out, was not up to the task of containing the winner, remained clear for the place. AGASTACHE bobbled start, raced within striking distance, moved up a bit closer on the outside late in the turn, floated out five wide into the lane, lacked a winning late kick, best of the rest. HAMAZING DESTINY well off the early pace, fanned six wide when making a modest advance late in the turn, lacked a further response the final furlong. STEAL YOUR FACE lacked early foot, picked off a few faltering foes in the late going while never dangerous. GRAND SENSATION within striking distance, loomed a mild threat four wide turning for home, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. CREDIT ONLY quick early, continued to narrowly show the way through the turn, gave way in the drive. SLATER'S PEANUTS forwardly placed early, staged a steady retreat while off the inside.
