GET RUNNIN' with the pace from the start toward the inside, rated through the turn, shook clear, steady handling. ALI'S KNOCKOUT back off the pace, four wide into and through the turn, proved no match for the winner, held sway for the place. RAVEN'S CLAW took up at the start, raced outside, five wide into the lane, roused for the drive, staged a mild rally to be slowly getting to the runner up late. TURA ISABEL prompted the pace off the inside, had little left for the drive. FARRARI STONE dueled up front off the inside, gave way in the drive. WHAT A JUSTICE raced off the pace, in some traffic toward the inside turn, lacked clear room late in the bend, moved out, roused, came up empty. JACUN back off the pace, saved some ground into the turn, moved out to be three wide into the stretch, also lacked a late bid. PAPARAZZI QUEEN was finished early, outrun.
