SILVER DANDY close from the start, vied three wide into and through the turn, disposed of the other speed nearing the furlong marker, roused, enough left to hold the runner up safe in the late going. LIMEHOUSE BLUES last away, trailed while out in the strip, staged a willing rally to be closing the gap on the winner. MOONRUSH vied up front along the inside, continued on equal terms with the winner upper stretch, could not match the winner final furlong, could not contain the runner up, lasted for the show. COACH broke awkwardly, moved up into the second flight under a hard hold, steadied repeatedly late backstretch, fell back, evenly through the stretch. PLEASANT VOW vied up front while between foes for a half, weakened in the drive. SACREDSPIRIT within striking distance toward the inside and in the second flight, lacked a response in the drive. CHIVAZONE four wide in the turn, moved a bit closer late in the turn, faltered in the drive. BOURBON KING finished early.
