CASSOULET in the second flight well off the inside, four wide into the lane still in hand, challenged soon after, long drive, proved narrowly best under spirited handling. IRISH DREAMER off the pace, waited behind the the leaders turning for home, challenged between foes, missed in the final strides. ONE LUCKY DEVIL broke well, set the pace along the inside, proved stubborn in the drive while continuing along the rail. PROSPECTIVE KISS trailed early while well wide, five wide exiting the turn, no match for the top three. OATMAN pressured the early leader outside that one, faltered. EXPLOSIVE GHAZIE last away, not a threat. HOLD'EM TIGER not a factor three wide. EURO SILVER JET with the pace three wide out of the turn, gave way.
