PRIZE MASTER with the pace from the start while three wide, disposed of the other speed in the turn, pulled away drive, lasted. VIGILANTE LAW broke in a bit then was pushed out soon after, raced back, split foes when straightened for home, finished up willingly to earn the place and was getting to the winner late. PRESTONS PRIZE broke out, settled off the pace, closer three wide turning for home, closest to the winner a furlong out, no match for that one or the runner up the final furlong, saved the show. BLUE HEAT void of speed, began to move late turn, split foes while four wide into the lane, some improvement with a mild, belated rally. MOSCOW ADVENTURE forwardly placed toward the inside, boxed in entering the turn, slight steady soon after, came up empty when clear for the drive. CORNELL pinched back at the start, trailed early as a result, switched out to be widest into the lane, improved position while never a serious threat. LATE HIT pushed out at the start, raced back off the pace, in some traffic late in the turn, angled out a bit for the drive, lacked a further response in the drive. COWBOY SHEIK with the pace while between foes, faltered after a half. SKIPPY WAS A HIPPY behind the pace, five wide into the turn, fanned six wide exiting, tired. JAMIES JESTER was outrun while racing outside. CANADIAN PACIFIC pushed out start, raced within striking distance, bothered when in tight turning for home in the five path, gave way through the stretch. PHATZO vied inside, stopped.
