Footnotes

BETTY R void of early foot, moved to the outside for the drive, staged a rally down the middle of the strip to win going away. BLAZING BELLE settled off the pace, began to rally in the second turn, angled out, took over outside the furlong grounds, no match for the winner late. HARD TO READ lacked speed while four wide in the first turn, again in the second turn, roused for the drive, too late for the place. RUNWAY STAR lacked speed, came five wide into the lane, improved position without posing a serious threat. BURJ chased the leader early, continued to race forwardly toward the inside, lacked clear room when going evenly a furlong out, continued to lack a bid waning strides. COUNTRY CAUCUS broke slowly, moved up to the middle of the pack, continued in that position into the stretch, lacked a kick the final furlong. PROUD CHARMER broke sharp, cleared to the inside, set the pace, faltered when headed turning for home. LITTLEMISSHOUDINI in the second flight, weakened in the drive. DANCINGWITHNOMUSIC lacked speed, failed to rally. DZIKI allowed to settle off the pace, backed up through the stretch. NOSEY WOLF remained back. R S VALENTINE staged a steady retreat.
