Footnotes

RACING BRAN got clear soon after the start to set an uncontested pace, modest fractions, shook off a tepid bid late in the second turn, stayed clear in the drive under steady urging. WIN WILLY lacked any form of early foot while off the inside, raced in some traffic into the second turn, angled out for the drive, fully extended late to be up for the place, no match for the winner. PROM SHOES bobbled start, fell far back after the start, continued to trail into the far turn while in hand and along the inside, angled out a bit for room in the drive, finished up willingly to gain the show. JONESBORO stalked the pace while just off the inside, roused with a right handed stick late in the final turn, lacked a significant response in the drive as he continued evenly to the finish. READY SET tucked to the inside soon after the start, continued to save ground into the lane, lacked a closing response. CROOK'S BODGIT closest to the winner for six furlongs, backed up through the stretch. GLAMOUR GUY four wide most of the way, had nothing for the drive in a dull effort. SPOTSGONE was finished early.
