MR ROSS broke with the field, allowed the speed to go, began a strong advance four wide in the second turn, challenged turning for home and proved best under pressure. CHARLEY GUNN, within striking distance off the inside, finished willingly between foes. CHIEF THREE SOX dueled up front off the inside and proved stubborn. RARE MONEY went evenly in lacking a serious late response. OUR TOWN vied up front along the inside until entering the stretch and gave way. STORMY DIPLOMAT, last away, was outrun while wide. THUNDER REEF showed brief speed three wide and stopped.
