LAUGH ABOUT, closest to the leader, collared that one into the stretch and slowly drew clear. ISLAND GETAWAY, forwardly placed, could not match strides with the winner while clear for the place. SCENIC VIEW came in at the start bothering inner rivals, got clear, set the pace for over a half and gave way the final furlong. ALARMING FABLE was four wide into the stretch in an even effort. INLAY, bothered at the start, made little impact. MAKIN' CALLS had little left inside. GRAB N GO came in at the start, raced within striking distance early and faded. RAHRAHSIXBOOMBAH was five wide much of the way. KRISTALDANCER, bothered at the break, swung out six wide for the drive and lacked a rally. BABY BABY BABY, forced back at the start, remained there. ME RESTLESS, bothered at the start, raced far back and was outdistanced after losing contact with the field.
