CALIBRACHOA closest to the early leader, moved on that foe late in the turn, narrowly showed the way into the lane, drew steadily clear. PERFECT DRIVE forwardly placed while outside, ranged up to challenge outside the winner late in the bend, could not keep pace with that foe in the drive, held the place. SONAR steadied a the start, moved a bit closer out of the turn, not enough for the place. GAMBLIN' JERRY void of early foot, moved outside, improved position late. WESTROCK GOLD four wide into the turn, moved toward the inside midway on the turn, failed to rally. BRASSY BOY bumped at the start, fell back, not a threat. MCCROCKLIN sprinted well clear after the start, set the pace for a half, stopped when confronted in the drive.
