**Footnotes**

WESTERN SUN lacked early foot, came five wide out of the turn, displayed some good late energy to be up in the final strides. RICKY TICK bothered at the start, in some traffic into the lane, altered course nearing the furlong marker, rallied, challenged late, missed. CONSERVATIVE VALUE closest to the leader off the inside and between rivals, advanced, took over turning for home, got clear, could not contain the top two late, narrowly held the show. MUCHO MACHO UNO lacked speed, came five wide turning for home, found best stride too late while remaining well out in the strip. DEVIL'S HAMMOCK in the second flight, raced four wide through the turn, lacked a winning bid when set down for the drive. LION'S DUB broke out, raced back off the pace, also lacked a significant response in the drive. DENALI SILVER sprinted clear soon after the start, vied through the turn and into the stretch closest to the inside, weakened in the drive. YUKONRUN bothered at the start, lost interest in the drive. SWOROVSKI off slowly, remained back throughout. ROCK THIS BAR forwardly placed along the inside, gave way. GRUNT trailed throughout.
