MOON CATCHER pushed in at the start, raced back early, came five wide into the lane when advancing, finished well down the middle of the strip. PRODIGAL DAUGHTER pinched back start, behind the pace, waited behind horses from late in the turn until midstretch, got through along the rail, finished up willingly. YES LEE behind the pace along the inside, rail bid turning for home, not enough late. BUY THE BARREL fell back to race off the pace, moved closer six wide into the lane, turned in an even finish. DANCE BAND vied up front, continued to do battle in the first flight past the furlong marker, weakened. INSTANT COVERAGE five wide into the turn when the leaders, lacked a late kick. GRAND IN GREY narrowly showed the way toward the inside, gave up the rail into the lane, faltered. HONKY TONK HOPPER not a threat. TIZ BEAUTIFUL contested the pace between foes and tired. THUNDERING JILL pace, gave way. COZZENE'S GOLD last away, trailed throughout.
