### Footnotes

BRANDON'S WAY never far back after breaking to the inside, ranged up three wide to challenge turning for home, showed the way past the furlong marker, drew clear late under firm handling. PROUD TWISTER behind the early leaders, moved closer in the turn, four wide into the stretch, brushed with ROAD TO SALEETA midstretch, narrowly held the place. BULLERO broke out to tighten up outer rivals, raced well back off the pace, roused three wide into the stretch, steered out, finished up willingly to narrowly miss the place. GOOD TIME COMING broke alertly, set or forced the pace for a half, continued to vie past the furlong maker, proved stubborn until late. WE HAVE RAINBOWS broke near the back, steadily advanced while four wide then five wide through the turn, flattened out once straightened for home. ROAD TO SALEETA in tight at the start, advanced turn, brushed stretch, finished up evenly. PRINCE PARTEE raced back off the pace, toward the inside in the turn, was never dangerous in the drive. FANTASTIC BULL off a bit slow, improved position slightly while also not a threat. BACKONTHEROAD shuffled back at the start, passed a few tiring foes while not a threat. DOWN AND OUT never menaced while racing off the inside. HESACOYOTE pushed out a bit start, quickly recovered to move up and duel for the lead inside, stopped in the drive. JUST JASON showed little while racing four wide.
