LAST TOOTS off the pace, made a good gain into contention the third quarter, fully extended in the drive to prove narrowly best. CHEYENNE SPIRIT settled off the pace, prompted the issue in the second turn, bid, showed the way past the furlong marker, could not match the winner in the final strides. VIRGINIA PLAIN lacked speed, rallied, up for the show in the late going. JUSTAKISS sprinted clear to set the pace, showed the way into the stretch, faltered. SMOKEY DIPLOMACY lacked a serious late bid. HUMBOLDT BELLE forwardly placed early, asked for some run, came up empty for the drive. PROSPECTORS SPIRIT broke sharp, settled off the pace, had nothing for the drive. MAE HAP forwardly placed for a half, gave way. HAPNIN trailed throughout.
