**Footnotes**

MIZZEN MAZE used early to get clear, rated in the run up the backstretch, continued to show the way by a large margin through the second turn and into the stretch, kept to task late to just hold the runner up safe late. DEEP DIVE void of early foot, circled five wide into contention out of the final turn, set down, finished well to be rapidly getting to the winner late. VOLTURI allowed to settle off the pace toward the inside, lacked closing bid to finish up best of the rest. FIFTH AVENUE SOUTH within striking distance off the inside, had little for the drive. MADE THE CUT saved ground, lacked room along the rail late in the final turn, continued inside in failing to mount a late bid. DREAM COMMANDER closest to the winner for six furlongs, gave way in the drive. HARTS ALIBI last away, lacked speed, trailed most of the way in showing little.
