BOWMANS CASTLE void of early foot, began to move into the far turn, rallied four wide out of the final bend, finished willingly to be up in time. LONGSHOT WARRIOR broke on top, set the pace while rating, responded when challenged late in the final turn and into the stretch, clear again late, could not contain the winner. COMPETENT lacked speed while off the inside, fell further back late in the second turn, moved out, staged a mild rally to be along for the show while well out in the strip. TIMELY PURSUIT settled off the pace, lacked a serious late response. SARATOGA RED prompted the pace, had little left for the drive and was tiring when in a bit tight past the furlong marker. HE'S SO PROUD within striking distance, advanced with a middle to challenge the runner up midway on the final turn, could not sustain that effort in the drive. GRANDPA GEORGE forwardly placed, moved a bit closer late in the final turn, lugged in a bit midstretch, weakened. REGIONS REWARD last away, failed to menace.
