UNSTOPPABLE U away in good order, set the pace, rated kindly up the backstretch, called on for some run into the lane, shrugged off TEXAS AIR nearing the furlong marker, held sway in the late going. NAJJAAR void of early foot, advanced four wide through the second turn, lost some ground to the winner entering the stretch, slowly getting back to that rival in the late going. TEXAS AIR broke in the air, recovered to race closest to the leader, continued to press into the lane, weakened in the late going. ON THE LOOSE AGAIN off the pace while saving some ground first turn, moved closer while continuing along the inside second turn, flattened out and went evenly to the wire. CRYPTOLIGHT allowed to settle off the pace, had little left for the drive. SATURDAY LAUNCH forwardly placed three wide into the first turn, chased the leaders up the backstretch, gave way from between rivals midway on the second turn. KATE'S MAIN MAN was finished early.
