Footnotes

JONESBORO broke sharp, quickly got clear and to the inside, cruised in setting the pace, given a breather third quarter, drew out stretch, driving. RED RAYMOND settled off the pace and the inside, four wide into lane, no match winner, well clear for second. MORE THAN REGAL took up while in tight along the rail into the first turn, recovered and continued to save ground, lacked a serious kick in the drive but was still well clear of the others. ROTARY forwardly placed while four wide most of the way, came up empty for the drive. THUNDER MISSION came out into the first turn, evenly paced throughout while off the inside, lacked a late kick. COMMANDER BUCK forwardly placed in the three path, weakened in traffic late in the second turn. ABSENT FRIEND fell back to trail just after the start, made little impact. MR. PURSUIT carried out early into the first turn, showed little. JOEY CARSON pressed, gave way.
