Footnotes

BIG CAL never far back, moved up to challenge four wide turning for home, shook clear, held the runner up comfortably safe under steady handling. TEMPO FIVE lacked early foot while off the inside, swung out to be five wide turning for home when advancing, could do little with the winner late. TALE OF A SAINT bothered slightly at the start, rallied three wide and inside of several rivals turning into the lane, late bid for the place, not enough while also going well at the end. CASEY'S ON CALL behind the leaders, fanned out seven wide turning into the lane, went evenly to the wire. RESCIND THE TRADE dueling up front in the three path, vied between rivals into the lane, weakened in the drive. ECONOMIC SWOON away in good order from the inside, steered out a bit, narrowly set the pace two path, also weakened when the real running started in the stretch. GRAND ROW in the second flight off the inside, had little for the drive. FOXY STEVE last to leave, never menaced. CONGA ROCK prompted the pace outside, nudged out six wide exiting the turn, stopped, distanced.
