### Footnotes

BEMATA behind the pace along the inside, raced in traffic through the turn, angled out once straightened for home, split foes with less than a furlong remaining, closed with good energy to prove best. TONKAWA void of early foot, raced well back early, steady advance while five wide through the turn, challenged on the outside with less than a furlong remaining, outkicked to the wire. D Y N FOR A STAR closest to the early leader, moved up to vie in the turn while off the inside, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker, could not contain the top two late. DENALI THUNDER bumped with CELIKNA DIAMOND at the break while breaking alertly, got clear early, vied along the inside turn, weakened the final furlong while continuing along the rail. SATURDAY'S SECRET broke out, raced back, moved closer four wide through the turn, flattened out in the drive. SOUTHERN BLAST last away, raced back while saving some ground, moved out in traffic late in the turn, made little impact in the drive. JEBIAS failed to menace while racing off the inside. SGT BILKO lacked early foot, came five wide out of the turn, passed a couple of tiring rivals. GOODER in a bit tight at the start, forwardly placed early, backed up in the drive. CELINA DIAMOND prompted the early pace, gave way in the turn. BENAGEN within striking distance while three, stopped.
