PILFER lacked early foot, ranged up four wide to challenge into the stretch, dueled past the furlong marker, put that rival away late, held the runner up safe in the late going. PLATINUM BALLETT settled off the pace while saving ground, behind horses into the stretch, finished willingly when clear while continuing up the rail and was rapidly getting to the winner late. CEDAR SUMMER stalked the pace off the rail, challenged three wide and between foes exiting the second turn, weakened in the late going. SOLITARY EMERALD chased the leader, challenged second turn, not enough late. FLAMING DIXIE broke on top, quickly sprinted clear, gave way when headed in the second turn. ROADSIDEATTRACTION last away, remained back. CROSSING PINEY finished early, well beaten.
