SILKY SUMMER broke on top, set the pace along the inside, responded when challenged, proved stubborn to the end. NEVADA MISS settled off the pace, steadied in traffic just inside the winner second turn, lost considerable ground to that same foe into the stretch, finished willingly while too late. MS. PURR behind the pace, lacked a late bid. CATALINDY within striking distance, also came up empty in the drive. SOCKSNSNEAKERS trailed for five furlongs, passed tiring foes while never a threat. COOKIE BIGHT COVE prompted the runner up for six furlongs and gave way in the drive. KISSMELIKEUMEANIT tired after a half. WILD AND RAKSHES finished early, well beaten.
