RELENTLESS LUV showed the way in hand and along the inside, set a comfortable pace, shook clear when straightened for home, held sway in the late going. GOLDRUSH LADY within striking distance, could do little with the winner the final furlong, clearly second best. DEVINE LIGHTENING prompted the pace while off the rail, had little left for the drive and weakened. DOLL AND A HALF evenly paced in lacking a late bid. DASHA lacked a serious bid. FUN TOWN also failed to rally. CHICKENPOTPIE broke a bit slow, no menace. NEELY never dangerous off the inside. KIPLINGS MOON tired. CENTER STAGE HONEY never close. KARA'S TEE outrun.
