OMIT settled off the early pace three wide, challenged four wide turning for home, long drive, narrowly best. SATCHEL in the second flight toward the inside, waited midway on the final turn, closer, long stretch duel closest to the inside, outfinished. PACAR void of early foot, three wide rally into the lane, finished best of the rest. GREEN DIGGER cleared toward the inside into the first turn, set the pace until a quarter remained, faltered in the drive. MARK HIS WORD far back in the early going, staged a belated rally three wide. TUMBLE CREEK hopped, off slow, moved up to race in the middle of the pack, came up empty for the drive. BET THE MOON broke well, chased the leader, gave way. SALT FORK had nothing for the drive. WHAT A PLACE was finished after a half.
