TAUM SAUK vied early while three wide, got clear and to the inside into the turn, shook off a bid late in the bend to be clear again, held late. HOLY DREAMER allowed to settle, behind the two leaders turning into the stretch, angled out a bit for room, steady gain the final furlong. KEEPINONESTEPAHEAD vied up front early while between foes, fell back off the winner, tried that one from the outside late in the bend, flattened out the final furlong. NORTHERN VOW lacked speed, staged a mild, belated rally toward the inside. QUIET THANKS lacked speed, came six wide out of the turn, little late gain. YORE trailed for a half, picked off a few tiring foes, never dangerous. POINTING HOME retreated. AFTER SHOCK five wide late in the turn, lacked a late kick. MANITO stopped in the drive, returned bleeding.
