KENTUCKY MAN set the pace while rating kindly along the inside, garnered a larger advantage a furlong out, held late. RICHLAND CREEK settled early while toward the inside, boxed in late in the second turn, upper stretch, angled out slightly nearing the furlong marker, finished up willingly to be getting to the winner. NAVY WINGS never far back, raced three wide throughout, lacked a winning kick in the drive. CREEKMORE lacked speed, came four wide into the stretch, staged a modest rally to improve slightly. GOLD NINER pressed the winner off that one's outside shoulder, gave way in the drive. RAVENSWORTH lacked a rally. NUMISMATIST lacked speed, came six wide into the stretch, failed to rally. CHIN HIGH was never involved. MENACING gave way in the drive in a dull effort.
