BAG TOSSER moved up to take control before a quarter, set the pace in hand, shook well clear into the lane, not threatened in the drive while being kept to pressure. BREATHTAKINGBREEZE off the pace, four wide through the turn, proved no match for the winner in the drive, dug in for the place. DEAR GRACE last away, trailed, improved along the inside, bid for the place, outfinished for the place. OPTIMISTIC SREVA raced back, off the inside, staged a tepid rally while moving through traffic. AUNTGRACE lacked speed, five wide into the lane, improved position outside. CURLEY KIM lacked a late bid. TETON DANCER bothered at the start, moved up to race within striking distance, had little left in the late going. LABELED failed to rally. DRESS IN DUBAI four out to five wide through the turn, lacked a late kick. DANCING FERN vied up front off the inside, tired in the drive. WHY WONDER WHY was finished early, raced wide. TRICKIN G forwardly placed, stopped.
