BRIEF VALENTINE pressed the pace, took over when straightened for home, could not contain the winner. BELAWAN moved closer the middle half, lacked a winning response. TRICKY DETAILS lacked a late response. UP PITTS CREEK dueled early, shook clear onto the backstretch, going comfortably up front, faltered drive. SHAGKIN wide second turn, no menace. VILLAGE GREEN gave way.
