MIGHTY ROAR with the pace on the outside, put a head in front on the turn, continued lead until late, could not contain the winner. HAWKISH pressured the pace along the inside, weakened in the drive, held the show. PHANTASTIC SECRET lacked a winning response. RUNNING BRAVE failed to rally. J. G.'S JAZZ trailed most of the way. MILITARY ZONE with the early pace, began a steady retreat after a quarter.
