Footnotes

UNJUST off a bit slow, circled six wide into the lane, finished full of run to be in time down the center of the race track. BERTSGOLDENMISSILE broke well, appeared to race forwardly, proved no match for the winner late, up late for the place. NEVILL'S MISTAKE set or forced the pace closest to the inside, led late, could not contain the winner, caught late for the place. OLYMPIC FLYER dueled up front off the inside, weakened. DELTA CHARLIE five wide late in the turn, finished up evenly. LIMIT THE WAGON lacked a late bid. SMILIN' DEL also failed to menace. BONDSTEEL bobbled start, no factor. WHISKEY MAN was outrun. DIAMOND LAD faded. HEAVY SNOW OBSCURED THE QUARTER AND HALF MILE POINTS OF ALL.
