MASARU slight brush start, forwardly placed from the start inside, edged forward along the rail to challenge late in the turn, dueled past the furlong marker, edged away late. HANG COOL broke alertly, showed the way off the inside early, dueled into the stretch outside the winner, could not keep up late, held sway for the place. ROSSCAT void of speed, came five wide out of the turn, rallied on the outside through the stretch, finished willingly to be getting to the runner up late. TITLETOWN FIVE forwardly placed, moved closer to challenge three wide into the stretch, lacked a further advance, finished up evenly. CALL ME KELLY brushed start, off the pace, raced in some traffic into the turn, toward the inside into the lane, lacked a closing kick. DIVINE THUNDER within striking distance, five wide through the turn, came up empty for the drive. BLUE CREEK crowded back at the start, made little impact in remained back. BRUVVER MAX broke in, brushed, steadied early in some tight quarters, had nothing for the drive. DENALI CAUSEWAY was never factor. PALE HOSE pressured the runner early on the outside, stopped in the turn.
