JIFFY WISH unhurried early, began to move after five furlongs, rallied four wide into the stretch, challenged past the furlong marker, kicked well clear. TRICKY DETAILS closest to the leader, took over from along the inside turning for home, proved no match for the winner. WESTERN TYPE settled off the pace, no match top two in the drive to finish best of the rest. TRICKY TAMI off a bit slow, lacked a late rally. ROSE TRICK sprinted clear soon after the start, large lead through quick splits, allowed the runner the rail entering the stretch, gave way badly. CHIKASKIA off slow, failed to menace. THE REAL JEWEL middle move, faltered. APPLES HOSS trailed, finished well back.
