RED N'GOLD closest to the leader for six furlongs in hand, challenged from the outside late in the second turn, quickly got clear when straightened for home, held on late. REASON TO TALK lacked speed, moved closer along the inside under slight restraint late in the second bend, angled out for the drive and finished well to close a late gap. MCKINNEY void of early foot, swung out six wide for the drive, coming late down the middle part of the strip. YALTA last away, raced back, improved position along the rail into the stretch, moved out a bit to get around a tiring foe, finished willingly. CURIOUS CONUNDRUM within striking distance, lacked a response in the drive. EAGLE LAKE set the pace toward the inside, gave way in the drive. SEE HOW SHE RUNS stalked the pace, faltered in the drive. DUE TO WIN fell far back after a half, distanced.
