HUMBLE SMARTY forwardly placed from the start, gained the advantage late in the turn, kicked clear through the stretch under steady handling. ILIKEWHATIAMDOING prompted the pace while three wide, proved no match for the winner when straightened for the drive, well clear of the others. SHORTY SMALL in the second flight while just off the inside, roused for the drive, no match top two. STORMIN STEVE four wide into the lane, went evenly through the stretch. JASONS JAXON raced outside, never dangerous. CINNAMON COWBOY bothered slightly at the start, fell back to mid back, failed to menace. LOUIS G broke alertly, set the pace for a half along the inside, faltered when headed. FIRE UP THE BELL steadily faded. ETHAN'S BANDIT shied in traffic just after the start, turned in an even effort while in some traffic. SMOKING KIP off slow, fell far back, modest late interest long after the issue had been decided. CLASSIC COWBOY wide into the lane, outrun. STORM CHANT was never involved.
