FOUR SEVENS garnered a comfortable advantage despite a quick opening quarter, clear into the turn, held sway in the drive under steady handling. MR. PINSTRIPE bumped at the start, lacked speed inside, angled out sharply late in the turn, finished willingly down the center of the track to get the place. FATHER TIME chased the leader into the turn, continued to press through the turn, evenly in the drive, held the show. SMILE AND TEARS away in good order, in the second flight through the turn, lacked a closing kick as he too was going evenly at the end. BRICK CREW off pace, in some traffic in the turn, failed to rally when clear for the drive. IMPECCABLE bumped at the start, moved up through that quick opening quarter, lacked clear room behind horses upper stretch, angled to the inside, modest late energy. TEA TAX forwardly placed, steadied into the turn when in a bit tight, faded. REAL EASY raced off the rail, made little impact. MATTY'S SONG five wide late in the turn, failed to respond. GOLDATWORK last away, remained back. ALLOWANCE always outrun. OUT OUR WAY raced four wide into the turn, retreated.
