Footnotes

FLATTER ME UP lacked early foot, dropped inside early in the turn, began to advance soon after, got through turning for home while continuing inside, put a head in front a furlong out, held the runner up safe in the late going under firm handling. BRIDAL TRAIN off the early pace, four wide in the turn, rallied into the stretch, challenged on the outside midstretch, unfinished to the wire. MRS. ROSA settled off the pace and the inside, between rivals and three wide inside the winner late in the turn, dropped to the rail when straightened for home, lacked a late kick, no match for the top two. CITY SLEWTIONS sprinted clear soon after breaking in good order, remained clear through the turn, weakened when headed by the winner nearing the furlong marker. RASPBERRY JAM lacked speed on the outside, three wide through the turn, failed to muster a rally in the drive. GOOD FRIDAY GAL last to leave, was never a factor. EXPECTING MONEY chased the leader for a half and gave way. DIXIE WARRIOR steadily faded off the inside.
